The Ramasastrulu-Munagala Prize 1924.

- 1. The Prize will be awarded in July this year.
- 2. The Prize will be in the form of a medal and will be awarded to the member of the Union who submits the best account, of original research or enquiry, carried out by him, on any agricultural subject.
- 3. The subject-matter shall not exceed in length twelve foolscap pages type-written on one side.
- 4. Intending competitors should notify the Secretary of the Madras Agricultural Students' Union not later than the 15th May 1924 the subject of the paper which they propose to submit and the paper should be sent in so as to reach the Secretary, Madras Agricultural Students' Union, not later than the 1st June 1924, with a covering letter showing full name and address of the sender. The author's name should not be shown on the paper which should be entered under a nom-de-plume.
 - 5. Four type written copies of the essays should be sent in.
- 6. The name of the successful competitor will be announced and the prize awarded at the time of the Conference in July 1924.
- 7. The Union reserves to itself the right of publishing all or any of the papers.
- 8. All references in the paper to published books, reports, or papers by other workers must be acknowledged.
